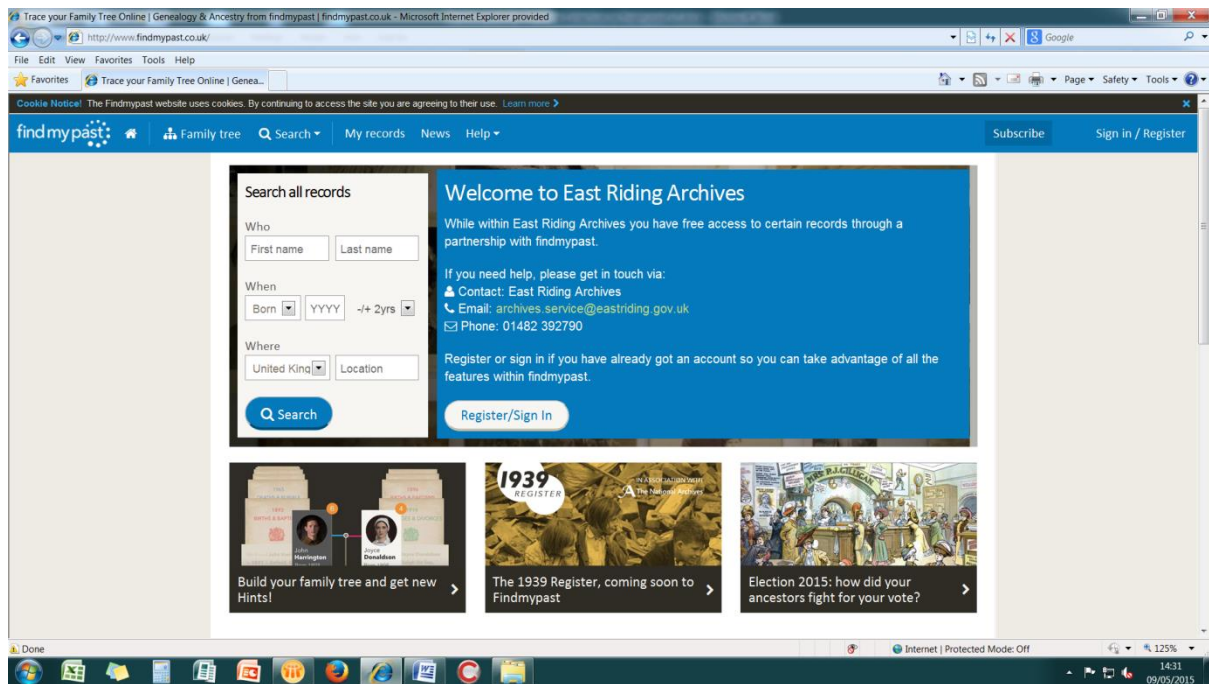
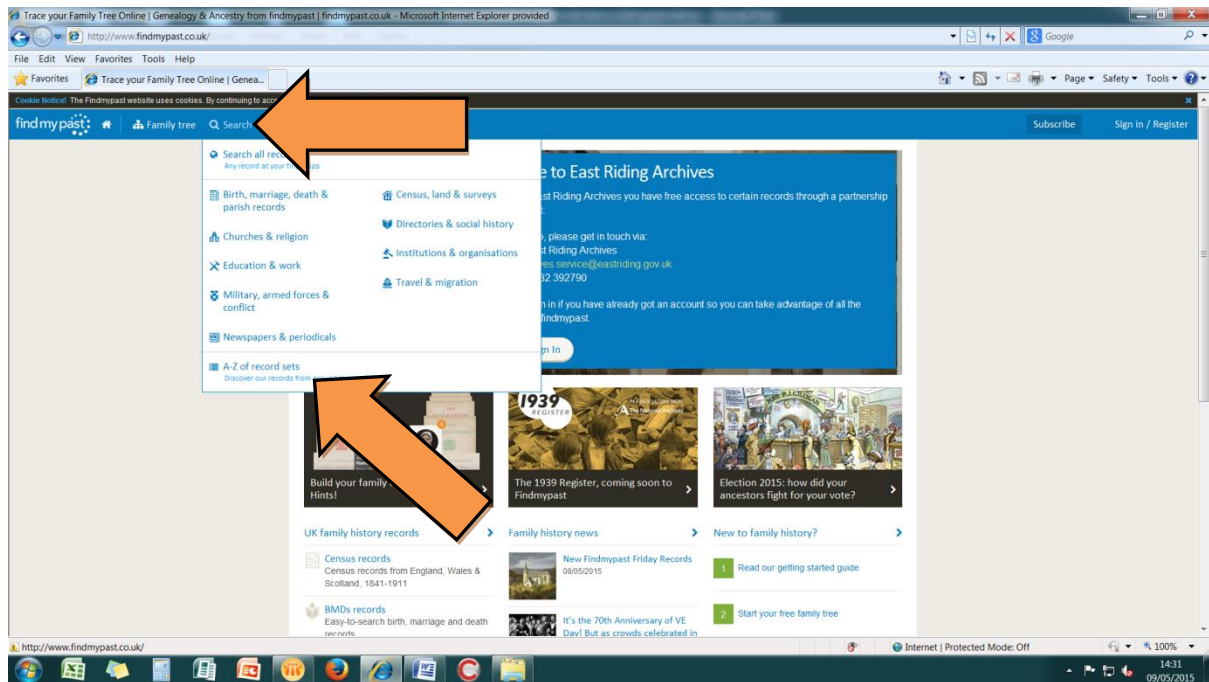


How to search the Yorkshire Collection on findmypast.co.uk

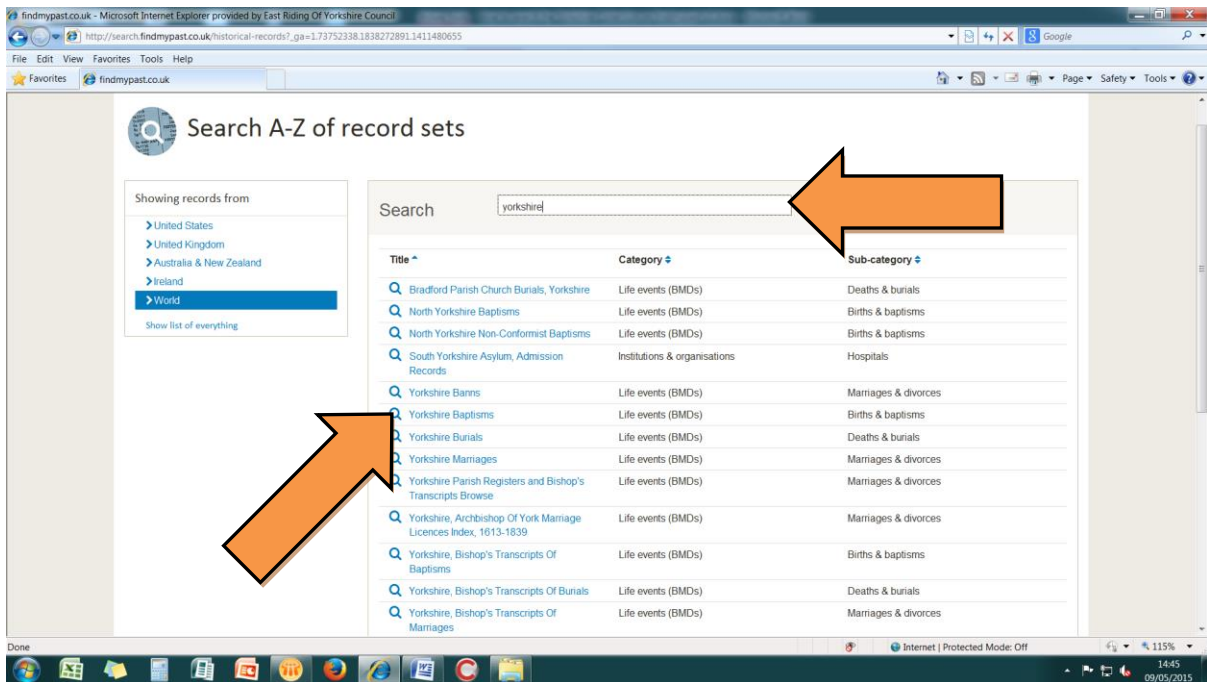
Welcome page for anyone using the service on an ERYC computer



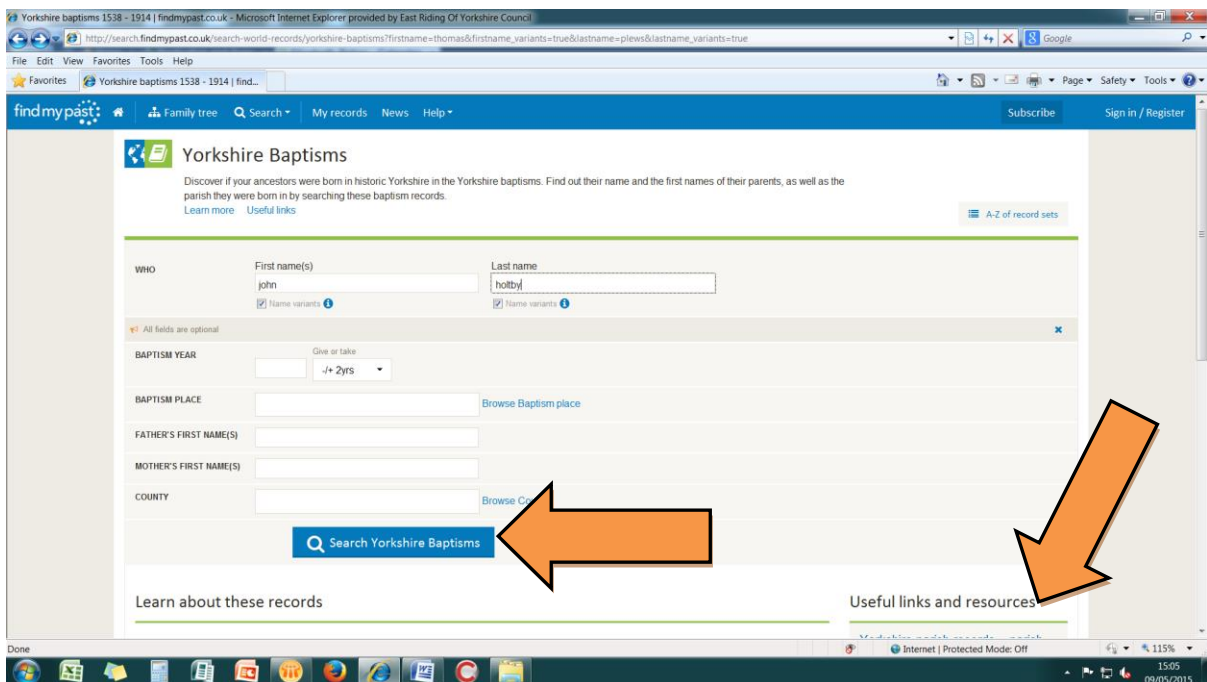
Click on 'Search' which brings up different types of records. Click on 'A-Z of record sets'



Type 'Yorkshire' into the search box. Then select either Yorkshire Banns, Baptisms, Burials or Marriages. There are also links to the Bishop's Transcripts.

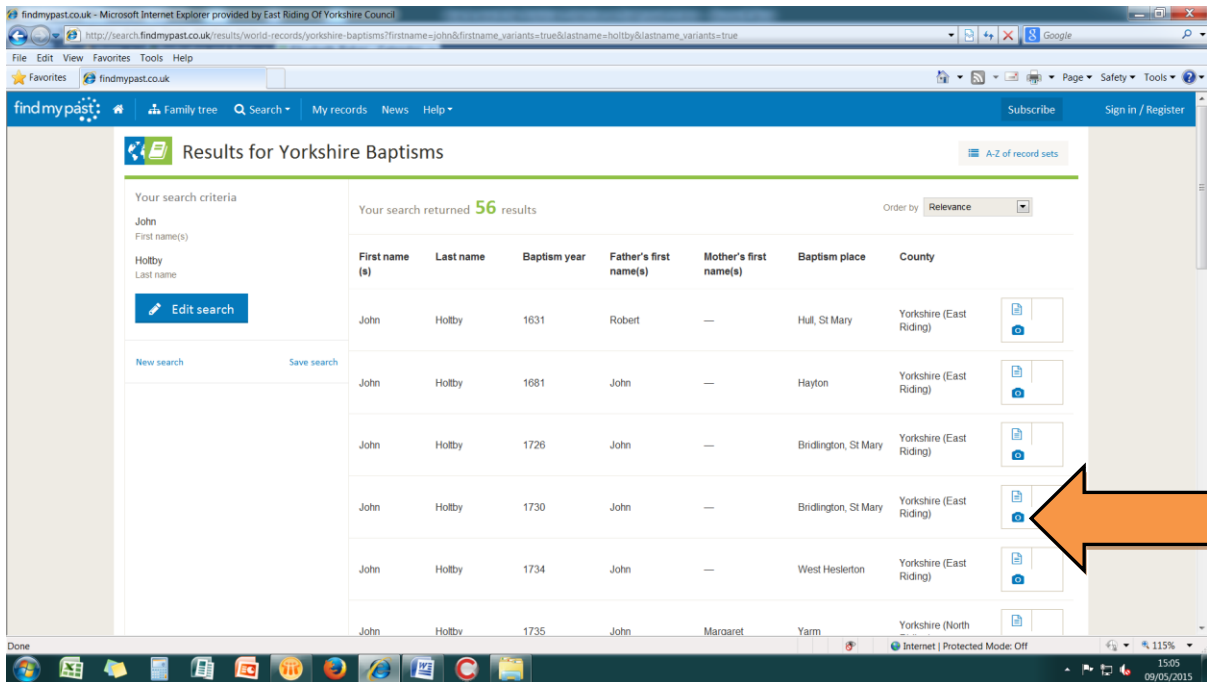


Type your search into the boxes given and select Search Yorkshire 'Baptisms'.

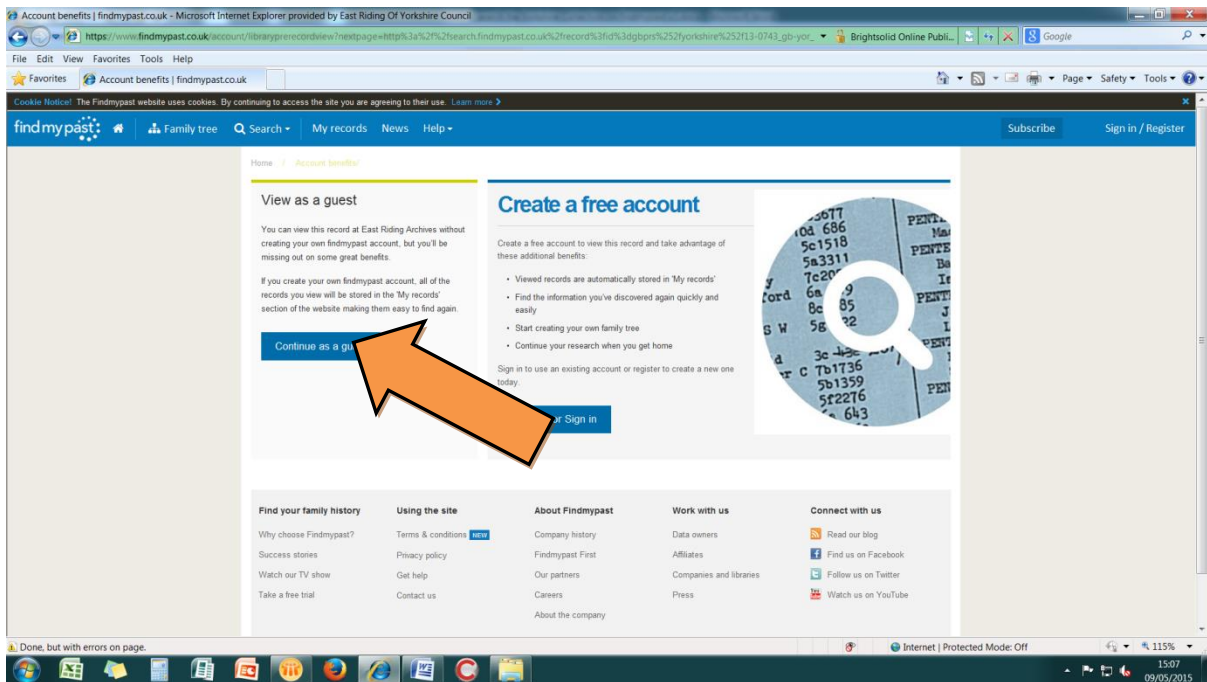


Further down this page there are also 'Useful links' to the other sections of the Yorkshire Collection.

This brings up the search results. You can either select to view a transcript or the image. Here we will select the camera icon to view the image.



The first time in each session you come across this page you will need to select 'View as a Guest'



The image of the archive will appear. It gives you the record type across the top of the page. Using the controls in the top left corner you can zoom in to find the entry you want, move around the page and select full screen. There is a view transcription button at the top if you can't read something. If you find an error please use the 'Report image error' button in the bottom right corner. There are also buttons for downloading and printing the record.
